THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned
do hereby associate themselves into a
corporation under and by virtue of the
provisions of an act of the Legislature

of New Jersey entitled "An Act to Incorporate Associations not for Pecuniary Profit,"
approved April 21, 1898, and the several supplements thereto and acts amendatory thereof,
and all revisions into which said acts have been incorporated.

FIRST: The name of this corporation shall be:

GARDEN STATE AMATEUR RADIO ASSOCIATION, INC.

SECOND: The purpose for which this corporation is formed are:

1. To secure the pleasures and benefits of the association of persons commonly
interested in amateur radio; to further better cooperation among the members of the association
to encourage and develop individual efficiency of the members of the association; and to do
anything and everything necessary or desirable to further the interest of radio in the general
community.
